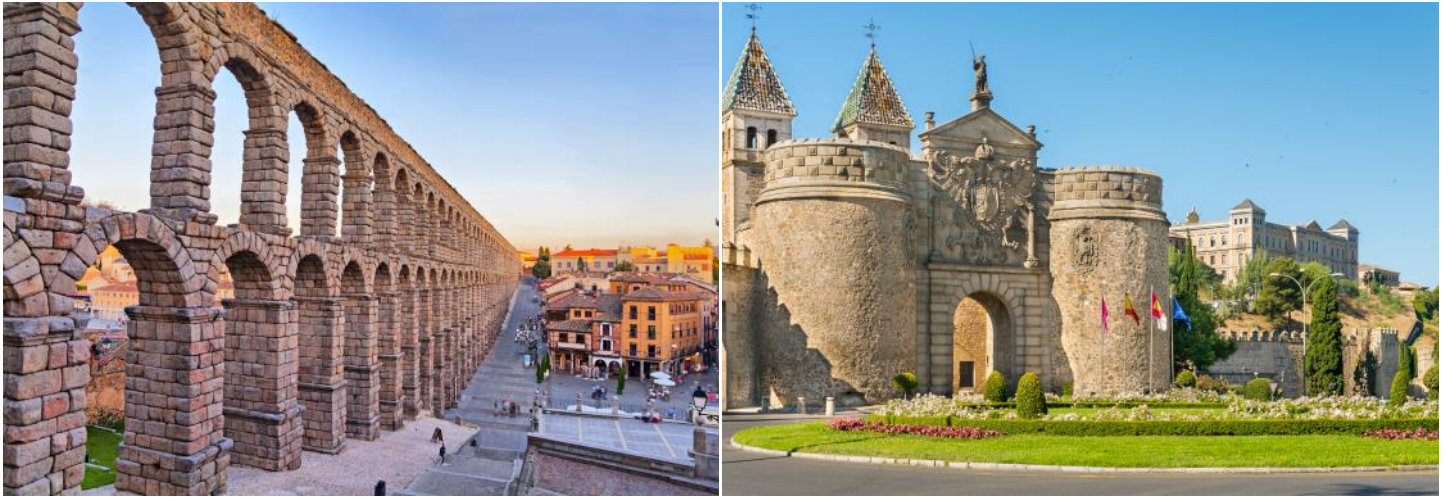

Come and discover the secrets and history of the Bom Retiro Park. Located in the heart of Madrid, its origins date back to the reign of Felipe IV, when the Bom Retiro Palace was built. It is a historic urban garden that covers a total of 118 hectares.
