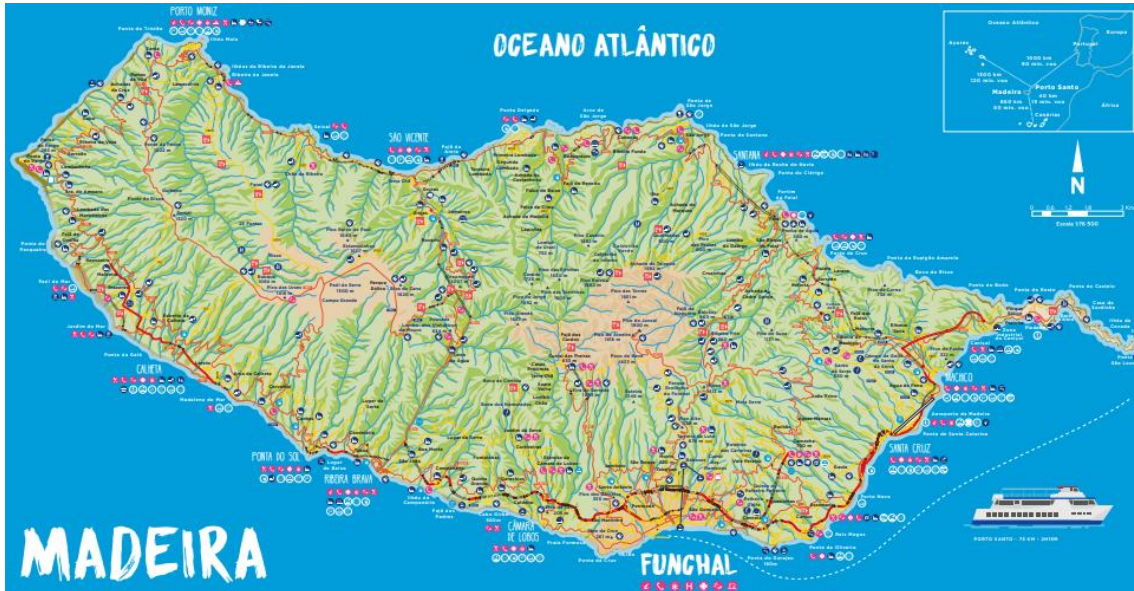

Language – Portuguese

Currency – Euro €

Weather (meteorology) – Madeira's climate is typically subtropical, with oceanic influences. Annual temperatures range from 18° to 27°.

Reduced mobility – Over the years, access for tourists with reduced mobility has improved notably, making the island a more inclusive and accessible destination. Public spaces are increasingly adapted, with ramps and adequate access. However, due to Madeira's mountainous geography, there are more isolated places that do not have the necessary conditions for people with reduced mobility. Security – Known as one of the Portuguese regions with the lowest crime rates, Madeira stands out for being a very safe tourist destination. Investing in security infrastructure , natural disaster monitoring system and policing.

How to get around within the Archipelago

Between the Islands:

Plane – There are regular flights from local companies that operate between Madeira Island and Porto Santo Island, lasting approximately 15 minutes. Some of these companies are [TAP Air Portugal](#) and [Binter Canarias](#).

Ferry – Traveling on a ferry between the islands is a very popular option. It is a unique way to relax and at the same time enjoy the fantastic sea views of Madeira. The only ferry operator between [Madeira Island](#) and [Porto Santo](#) is [Porto Santo Line](#), whose ferry is called Lobo Marinho and lasts 2h30.

Inside Madeira Island:

Car – Renting a car is the perfect option for all those looking for autonomy and convenience. It's one of the best ways to get around the island, as you'll have access to more remote areas. Taxi – Choosing this form of transportation is a practical and comfortable option for touring the region. These taxis are yellow and have a blue stripe, and are generally driven by local people, who know most of the island's routes and the main tourist attractions.

What to see

Top-10 attractions



Pico do Arieiro – Located on Madeira Island, Pico do Arieiro is one of the highest and most magnificent points on the island. At approximately 1818 meters, this splendid place offers spectacular panoramic views of the archipelago. From here, it is possible to reach [Pico Ruivo](#) via trails between the mountains , a place that is also worth visiting.

Typical Houses Santana – Santana is a charming village in the north of [Madeira Island](#) . Famous for its buildings called Casas de Santana. Featuring a unique traditional architecture, white with red and blue elements and triangular thatched roofs. Without a doubt, a tourist and cultural symbol of Madeira!

Ponta de São Lourenço – Located on the eastern tip of Madeira Island, this rocky peninsula is famous for its arid landscape. Presenting a striking contrast with the rest of the island, which is more green and mountainous. Perfect place for walks, trails, while enjoying spectacular landscapes.

Cabo Girão – Considered one of the highest cliffs in Europe, measuring around 580 meters high. Here, there is a glass platform, offering stunning panoramic views to all visitors.



Laurissilva Forest – Classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the Laurissilva Forest is one of the island's main attractions, located mainly in the most mountainous areas of the North. In the [Madeira Natural Park](#), in [Ribeira Brava](#), [São Vicente](#) and [Porto Moniz](#), Slopes of [Serra de Água](#), [Encumeada](#) and in the Levada Zone of [Caldeirão Verde](#) and [Queimadas](#).

Monte Palace Jardim Tropical – Known as a lush botanical garden in Funchal, this place offers a vast and opulent collection of exotic plants and fabulous landscape settings. Here, you will have the opportunity to experience a moment of deep connection with nature.



Farmers Market – Located in the heart of Funchal, this market is one of the most emblematic places in Madeira. It is a vibrant and colorful space, with countless stalls selling fresh vegetables, tropical fruits,

exotic flowers and local products. Visiting this place will be a unique way to experience Madeiran culture to the fullest.

Levada das 25 Fontes – Located in the lush Laurissilva region, this trail provides an unparalleled experience for all nature and *trekking lovers*. Taking visitors along a route, full of stunning natural landscapes, ending at an impressive lagoon.

Curral das Freiras – Located in the Municipality of Câmara de Lobos, approximately 20 km from Funchal, this picturesque village, surrounded by steep mountains, is known for its captivating natural landscapes. Being the perfect destination for trail and hiking lovers.

Madeira Botanical Garden – This garden is one of the island's top tourist attractions, providing visitors with a vibrant experience of natural beauty and unique biodiversity. Here, visitors can explore over 2,000 species of plants, enjoying the serene environment and biodiversity of this place. Explore [other attractions](#) on Madeira Island!

exotic flowers, typical products, fruits and very fresh fish. This shopping place is a true immersion into the soul of Madeira.



Stroll through the Wonderful Madeiran Gardens – If you are a nature lover, we invite you to visit some of the most beautiful and unique gardens in Madeira. This will be an opportunity to connect with nature and enjoy the natural landscapes that these places offer. Some of the best-known gardens are: [Monte Palace Madeira](#) , [Madeira Botanical Garden](#) , [Palheiro Gardens](#) , [Funchal Municipal Garden](#) , among other natural spaces.

Explore the most Iconic Waterfalls in Madeira – With rugged terrain and a subtropical climate, the island of Madeira has countless natural waterfalls, many of them hidden along fascinating trails. The main ones are: [Cachoeira das 25 Fontes](#) , listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site; [Lagoa do Vento, Rabaçal](#) ; [Caldeirão Verde, Queimadas](#) ; [Levada Nova Waterfall](#) ; [Cachoeira dos Anjos](#) ; [Véu da Noiva Waterfall](#) , among others.

Visit the Natural Pools of Madeira Island – Formed by volcanic lava, these pools offer clear waters and an impressive landscape of rocks sculpted over the years. The most famous are: the Natural [Pools of Porto Moniz](#), with free access in some areas; the [Natural Pools of Seixal](#); [Doca do Cavacas](#) (Poças do Gomes), among other places.



Stroll through the most Iconic Streets and Avenues of Funchal – In addition to its unique natural beauty, Madeira is known for its cultural and historical richness, visible in its picturesque streets. The most visited are: [Rua de Santa Maria, Funchal](#), which stands out for its colorful doors, painted by born artists. Other places of great interest are [Avenida Arriaga](#), [Avenida do Mar](#), in [Funchal](#), among others.

Riding the iconic Basket Carts – Created in the 19th century, this ancient Madeiran tradition takes visitors on a true adventure aboard a

wicker cart. The route takes around 10 minutes, starting in Freguesia do [Monte](#) to [Funchal](#), offering tourists a variety of spectacular panoramic views.

Old Town Funchal – At dusk, the streets of the Old Town of Funchal come to life and are full of residents and tourists who want to experience nights of great entertainment and live music. Some of the most famous bars are: Mini Eco Bar , 23 Barra Vintage , Banana's Pub and the legendary Venda Velha.



Madeira Casino – Opened in 1937, the Madeira Casino is one of the main entertainment spots on the island. Offering a variety of games from roulette, *blackjack* , *poker* and slot machines . And cultural events, shows, shows and exhibitions.

The Factory – This is one of Madeira's most iconic nightclubs, famous for its vibrant, industrial atmosphere, reminiscent of an old factory. It offers a very diverse musical program with electronic, *techno*, *hip hop* and *R&B*.

Copacabana – Located in Funchal, Copacabana Madeira is a club that is a reference in the island's nightlife, known for its privileged location, sea views and its lively and elegant atmosphere. Here, a variety of music predominates, from the most commercial hits to more alternative styles.

Vespas Club – With modern decor and a vibrant atmosphere, this nightclub is one of Madeira's most iconic. Featuring a variety of electronic music, with local and international DJs.



GPoint Funchal – This bar, located in Funchal, is known for its modern and relaxed atmosphere, ideal for anyone looking to have a great time. The bar's speciality is its creative and classic cocktails, and it offers a varied programme of live music and *DJ sets*.

Hole in One – A very popular *pub* in Funchal, with a *chill atmosphere* and live music. Perfect for all lovers of classic and contemporary rock, *pop* , *pop rock* , *blues* , *jazz* , traditional Irish music and *folk* . An absolute must-see!

2026 Events (Parties, Shows, Festivals)

Madeira Carnival (February) - The Madeira Carnival is one of the island's most lively festivals, with allegorical parades, decorated floats, samba groups, and plenty of fun in the streets of Funchal. It's an event that attracts thousands of visitors and celebrates the joy before the Lenten period.

Madeira Autonomy Day (April) - This regional holiday celebrates the political and administrative autonomy of the Autonomous Region of Madeira. It includes official ceremonies, cultural activities, and moments of reflection on Madeiran identity and history.

MIUT – Madeira Island Ultra-Trail (April) - An international trail running race that crosses the island from end to end, passing through mountains, trails and unique natural landscapes. It attracts athletes from all over the world and promotes Madeira as a sports tourism destination.



Flower Festival (April/May) - An event celebrating the arrival of spring, transforming Funchal into a true open-air garden. It includes floral parades, flower carpets, exhibitions, and the symbolic Wall of Hope, built by children.

Madeira Classic Car Revival (May) - A festival dedicated to classic cars, where vintage vehicles parade through the streets of Funchal. It combines a passion for motoring, nostalgia, and excitement, attracting collectors and curious onlookers alike.

Atlantic Festival (June) - Marks the start of summer in Madeira with cultural shows, concerts and international fireworks competitions, which light up Funchal Bay for several weekends.



Popular Saints' Festivals (June/July) – Popular celebrations in honor of Saint Anthony, Saint John, and Saint Peter. The festivities include street parties, traditional music, dances, grilled sardines, and lots of entertainment in the island's parishes.

Funchal Jazz Festival (July) – A jazz festival that brings together national and international artists, with open-air concerts in emblematic locations in Funchal. It is a key cultural event in the Madeiran summer.

Madeira Rally (August) – The biggest motor racing competition in the region, part of the national rally calendar. It attracts many motorsport fans and takes place on the island's winding and challenging roads.



Madeira Wine Festival (August/September) - Celebrates the winemaking tradition of the region, highlighting the famous Madeira Wine. Includes wine tastings, reenactments of the grape harvest, folk music and cultural events in Funchal and Câmara de Lobos.

Nature Festival (October) - An event dedicated to promoting nature and active tourism, with activities such as hiking, canyoning, bird watching and environmental workshops, highlighting the natural richness of Madeira.

Christmas festivities (December) - During the month of December, the Christmas spirit arrives in Madeira in grand style! The streets are decorated with lights and Christmas decorations, there are live shows and Christmas markets.

New Year's Eve Party and Fireworks Show (December 31st) –

This is Madeira's most famous celebration, with parties all over the island, full of entertainment and music. The highlight of the night is the fireworks show. The fireworks display is considered one of the best in the world, capable of enchanting countless tourists and locals alike. Join a [New Year's boat tour](#) and witness this splendid visual spectacle!
